## PROBLEM:

## SOLUTION

- 1. Use your digital Camera to find the images listed. You can take multiple shots of the same image. A minimum of 36 different items on the list are required.
- 2. Make sure that all of your images are in focus and well lit.
- 3. Upload images into your folder.
- 4. You should have 2 subfolders. Subfolder #1 will have all of your unedited images in it. Call this Scavenger Hunt.
- 5. Subfolder #2 should be called Scavenger Finals. It should contained 5 edited images. Your 5 best from the scavenger hunt.

## **TIPS**

- 1. Think outside the box! Don't just photograph the obvious.
- 2. ALWAYS check your light meter!!!!
- 3. Use the rule of thirds!
- 4. Dead center is dead!
